Calculation of International Relations Major Grade Point Average September 21, 2005

A student's International Relations grade point average (GPA) is the highest GPA that can be calculated from any set of courses sufficient to complete the major, plus grades from IR 388, if any.

This means that:

- -All grades in core courses must be counted.
- -If a student takes more advanced courses, area studies courses, or free electives than needed to satisfy the major, only the highest set of grades sufficient to satisfy the major will be used.
- -Taking more courses than necessary to complete the major can increase a student's major GPA but cannot reduce it.
